The Temple served as the center of Jewish life...

- Community Gatherings
 - Religious Meetings
 - Education/Teaching
 - Worship of God
 - Atonement of Sin

Right after Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem... *Matthew 21:1-11*

Jesus enters the Temple and begins to clear house... Matthew 21:12-17

(Jesus) said to them, "The Scriptures declare, 'My Temple will be called a house of prayer,' but you have turned it into a den of thieves!"

- Matthew 21:13

Isaiah 56:7 | Jeremiah 7:11

This is where God dwelled among His people. Jesus saw the Temple being misused... The enterprise of sacrifice selling had taken precedence over coming into the presence of God.

This scene has been depicted in a variety of ways, and yet what remains clear...

Jesus was disgusted at what was transpiring in His Father's house.

God's desire to be with us and for us to be with Him. When we come into His presence...

> **God should be prioritized.** Nothing should distract us away from Him.

All should be welcomed. Access should not be limited to anyone.

Accountability should be expected. We should be held responsible for our actions. They were stealing the sacredness of the space that had been set apart for the communing with God.
