...signifying the separation between God's holiness and humanity's sin.

Then Jesus shouted again, and he released his spirit. At that moment the curtain in the sanctuary of the Temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.

The correlation between Jesus' death on the cross and the tearing of the Temple curtain is one of the most spiritually significant phenomena in scripture.

The perfect sacrifice "without blemish" for the whole of our sin "pierced for our rebellion" was complete. "it is finished"

Jesus died on the cross.

The curtain tore in two.

Sin no longer separated.
