This happened because Abraham believed in the God who brings the dead back to life and who creates new things out of nothing.

# The God who brings the dead back to life.

Just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by the same Spirit living within you.

- Romans 8:11

# The God who creates new things out of nothing.

The entire universe was formed at God's command, that what we now see did not come from anything that can be seen.

**- Hebrews 11:3** 

It's easy to believe in this God when life is good, but keeping that faith during the unknown, the improbable, and the absurd is when you are counted as righteous.

People are counted as righteous, not because of their work, but because of their faith in God who forgives sinners.

- Romans 4:5

Believing in THE God leads to stronger faith and greater hope, which leads to righteous living.

The inside affecting the outside, not the outside affecting the inside.

If faith leads to righteousness, (as opposed the other way around) then why do we spend so much time emphasizing righteous living before a foundation of faith?

And when God counted him as righteous, it wasn't just for Abraham's benefit. It was recorded for our benefit, too...
