Three Critical Considerations PLACEMENT

When choosing the location for your tent... avoid rocks and roots, slopes can be problematic, and be aware of the water shed.

Three Critical Considerations PLACEMENT

As Christ-Followers we must place our faith on the foundation of God; defining our decisions, relationships, and priorities.

Three Critical Considerations PLACEMENT

Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding.

Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

Three Critical Considerations POSITIONING

The direction your tent faces matters... turn it toward the sun and safety, away from the wind, and keep beauty in mind.

Three Critical Considerations POSITIONING

As Christ-Followers we must position our faith toward Jesus; recognizing our purpose, peace, and power come from Him.

Three Critical Considerations POSITIONING

Let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith.

Three Critical Considerations PROTECTION

It's important to make sure your tent is secure... the rain fly should be correctly attached and the stakes anchored properly.

Three Critical Considerations PROTECTION

As Christ-Followers we must protect our faith by anchoring ourselves to the Holy Spirit's gifting and equipping.

Three Critical Considerations PROTECTION

When the Father sends the Advocate as my representative – that is, the Holy Spirit – he will teach you everything and remind you of everything I have told you.
