The Harvest teaches us about obedience.

For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven...

A time to plant and a time to harvest.

- Ecclesiastes 3:1-2

A successful harvest requires an obedience to the law of the land...

Timing | Tending | Trusting

"If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands, I will send you the seasonal rains. The land will yield its crops, and the trees of the field will produce their fruit."

- Leviticus 26:3-5

"Your threshing season will overlap with the grape harvest, and your grape harvest will overlap with the season of planting grain. You will eat your fill and live securely in your own land."

Obedience to God yields a harvest of blessing...

Soil of Obedience PREPARING THE HEART

"Plant the good seed of righteousness, and you will harvest a crop of love. Plow up the hard ground of your hearts, for now is the time to seek the Lord, that he may come and shower righteousness upon you."

- Hosea 10:12

Soil of Obedience PREPARING THE HEART

We need to acknowledge the hard ground in our life caused by delayed or resisted obedience... SIN. Growth is impossible with a hard heart; it needs to be tilled through obedience.

Soil of Obedience PREPARING THE HEART

Be a "Farmer of Faith" like Ezekiel...

He obeyed God's command to prophesy a restoration that would transform the stony, stubborn hearts of God's repentant people into tender, responsive hearts. (Ez. 36:26)

Seed of Obedience TRUSTING GOD'S PROCESS

Don't just listen to God's word.

You must do what it says. Otherwise,
you are only fooling yourselves. For if you
listen to the word and don't obey, it is like
glancing at your face in the mirror.

- James 1:22-23

Seed of Obedience TRUSTING GOD'S PROCESS

Just as a seed needs to be planted, so does the Word of God. Obedience often begins in hidden places; although unseen beneath the surface, we need to trust it will bear fruit.

Seed of Obedience TRUSTING GOD'S PROCESS

Be a "Farmer of Faith" like Abram...

He obeyed when God called him to leave home and travel to some undisclosed, far-off land. He trusted God without knowing where God was taking him. (Heb. 11:8)

Fruit of Obedience REAPING THE REWARD

"If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully keep all his commands that I am giving you today, (He) will set you high above all the nations of the world. You will experience all these blessings if you obey the Lord your God."

- Deuteronomy 28:1-2

Fruit of Obedience REAPING THE REWARD

The harvest is a result of obedience. We cannot get distracted when God's blessings aren't instant; a delayed harvest doesn't mean a denied harvest... the fruit is always worth it.

Fruit of Obedience REAPING THE REWARD

Be a "Farmer of Faith" like Joseph...

He obeyed God and remained faithful despite the difficulties he endured; explaining to his brothers that God's plans were bigger than the evil they intended. (Gen. 50:20)
